



CYCLE TRAINING - BIKEABILITY COURSES 2016

Wigan Borough Council is pleased to announce that they will be running Summer Holiday Courses to help children in the borough improve their cycling skills – these courses will be run by our training provider ‘*Cycle Experience*’.

Bikeability Level 1 & 2 is aimed at 10 to 14 year olds who can already ride a bike. The course will run over 4 consecutive days (2 hours per day) and will be **either** a morning or afternoon course (not a combination). On Monday the first hour (Level 1) is delivered in a traffic free environment to establish children are safe to go onto the roads for the Level 2 training.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

CHILDREN MUST BE ABLE TO RIDE A BIKE as this course is about increasing confidence and learning to ride safely on quiet roads. This course is **NOT** teaching anyone how to ride a bike. Children must have a roadworthy bike (BMX bikes are welcome but must have both front & rear brakes and no stunt pegs) and a cycle helmet that fits properly. **Children will be riding in traffic so it is essential that they are able to control their bike, signal, look behind them, brake safely and concentrate for 2 hours at a time.**

For children to attend one of these courses, the great news is that there is no charge. However, we would ask that parents drop off and collect children at the given times on each day.

Numbers of children for each course are limited to a maximum of 8 to ensure safety on the roads so bookings will be accepted on a first come first served basis.

DEADLINE FOR BOOKINGS RECEIVED: TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO THE START OF A COURSE.
