Impact of School Closures

We appreciate how difficult this first half term has been for many of our families due to us having to close some classes. At this time we have to take suspected Covid symptoms seriously and ask children or staff to be tested before coming into school.

On the rare occasion we have had a positive test result then we have had to take follow government guidelines of isolating all those that have had close contact. We take this tracing very seriously and work hard to make sure all contacts are informed. Because of this we have had isolated cases rather than seeing a large spread of the virus.

I thank you for your support and understanding in this. If your child has not been contacted directly to self-isolate it is very important they remain in school. When children are off work is provided via our school website and can be found under your child's class page through Twitter or Office 365. Currently it is a legal requirement that school work is completed by children who have to remain at home. If there is difficulty accessing work on line it is important that school is informed so that paper copies can be provided.

Have a lovely half term. Please keep an eye out for changes in the tier system in our local area. Keep contact to a minimum and let's work together to reduce the impact of Covid.

Fitness Training

Every week we have PE lessons in school. Some are run by the class teacher and some are run by WLCT. Each half term we will also be using some of our Sport's Premium money to buy in a PE expert. Over the past 2 Fridays he has been into school and worked with each class in turn to develop circuit training skills. Staff too have attended these sessions to build up their own skills and to be able to continue these kinds of activities with the children. All the children have really enjoyed these sessions and engaged well. We hope to be as fit as fleas at the end of the school year!

Social Distancing

It is wonderful to see so many of our children eager and ready for school. Please help us keep everyone safe by not turning up to school until close to the opening time of their class. Nurseries open their doors between 8:30-8:50am. Reception-Year 6 open their doors between 8:40-9am. Thank you for supporting us with our one way system. We appreciate this can make the journey longer but we feel it is worth it to keep everyone as safe as possible.
