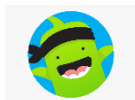
Our Learning & Play Theme is...

'Blooming Lovely'

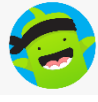

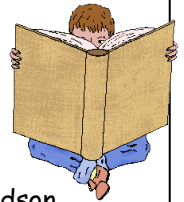
