Speaking, Listening and Writing	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Write a short character description describing the Queen of Hearts 2. Design your own front cover for the story Alice’s Adventures in Wonderland. 3. Break the following Year 4 spellings down into syllables, then, choose 3 to put into a sentence (calendar, experiment, disappear, important, medicine)
Problems, Science and Maths	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Draw a diagram to show a food chain that includes a producer, prey and predator. 2. Choose a multiplication table that you need to work on and practise it then ask a teacher to test you and reward you with house points. 3. Design an information poster about tooth decay and how to prevent it.
Art and Design	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Design a comic strip reflecting your favourite story. 2. Design a new front cover for a book you have studied in class or one of your favourite books from last year. 3. Create and sketch your own character for the Barnabas Project.
Constructing and Creating	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Create a piece of jewellery the Ancient Greeks might have worn. 2. Plan and make a model of the Barnabas Project character you have sketched. 3. Create your own Class Agreement for teamwork and collaborative group work.
