Dear Parents



Due to the latest advise from the government and other agencies we need to postpone any events to parents between now and Easter. This is to keep our children, staff and families as safe as possible.

Events will include:

- Parent's Meetings
- Class Assemblies
- Wednesday morning class sessions
- Easter Bingo
- Visits to the Library
- Early Years Pyjama Party
- Drumming Assembly
- Coffee Mornings
- Any baby clinics/toddler groups provided by external providers

This is as a precaution to prevent any unnecessary contact for anyone from our school community and to help prevent the spread of the Covid-19 virus.

After school clubs will run as usual for now, unless you have heard otherwise for specific clubs. Breakfast and after care club will continue to run as normal.

At the moment there has been no call for schools to close. If this does happen we have prepared work for children, much of which would be posted on-line using the schools Facebook page and Class Dojo. It would be useful to get the details of these if you do not already have them.

At the moment staff are busy teaching the children already in school so are unable to provide for individual cases. Work on-line would only be available if school had to close. I am working closely with the local authority to figure out how we could make food available in the event of a forced closure but at the moment I have no further information.

We do have a number of staff off work at present, either due to symptoms of the virus or because of self-isolation due to family members not being well. This is to ensure the children in school remain as safe as possible.

I urge you to follow the guidelines that if your child displays symptoms of:

- A temperature
- A new continuous cough

If any member of the household displays symptoms then all other members need to selfisolate for 14 days to give time for any symptoms to show.

I thank you for your continued support and patience at this difficult time and know you will understand that the measures we have taken are to keep our children safe.
