Thank you for showing an interest in the post at Marsh Green Primary School. I hope the following information will be useful.

Marsh Green is a primary school within the Borough of Wigan and currently there are 413 pupils on roll. The school has recently been extended and is two-form entry throughout. We also have two Nurseries and take children from 2 years old. We are proud to have become a Resourced Provision for a small number of children from across the borough, to support them with additional needs. The percentage of children entitled to free school meals is well above the National average, as is our proportion of children with SEND. The school was last inspected in September 2017 and was described as 'Good' in all areas.

We have a strong nurturing ethos and have been awarded the Nurturing Schools Award. We have an extensive Nurture provision which helps meet the needs of our most vulnerable pupils. We have a number of staff qualified to deliver training in a range of areas, inside and outside of school.

We have extensively developed our Outdoor Learning offer, enabling all children to have a weekly session and provide some Forest School sessions for identified children. Many children take part in the extra-curricular activities on offer and we are proud of our links with parents.

Governors play a very active role in supporting the children and staff. We also have an active School Council, enabling our children to have their say in their school.
